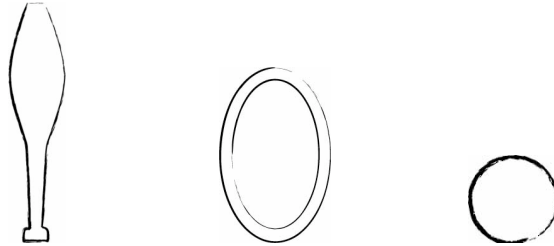

I first was amazed by juggling at age 7, when my dad haphazardly juggled three tennis balls. By the end of high school I joined a club and started to get serious about juggling (I rode my unicycle to the International Baccalaureate final exams). By college I started my own campus juggling club, and now I've formed **three** juggling clubs of my own throughout Colorado including "The Denver Juggling Club - Jugglers with Altitude."

Now I juggle professionally, maintain the juggling club, teach juggling to kids and adults alike, and am constantly learning and exploring new reaches of the juggling art form.

Next Question - What All Can You Do?:

I juggle anything I can get my hands on. Rings, balls, clubs, machetes... How many? Up to five, maybe six. I spin diabolo. I balance on the rolla-bolla. I ride a "normal" and a 6-foot-tall unicycle. I jump and dance around and juggling on my awesome new Jumping-Stilts. I've got themed costumes and fun creatures. And much more...
